

SUBJECT: Discontinuance of the Performance Analysis System (PAS) by ICE  
Investigations

On October 2, 2003, the Director, Office of Investigations (OI) mandated that immigration statistics continue to be reported by SAC offices through the Performance Analysis System (PAS) for the first six months of the fiscal year (FY) 2004. Following a comprehensive review of PAS and (b) (7)(E) and (b) (7)(E) statistical information for the first half of FY-04, Office of Investigations, Mission Support, Executive Information Unit, and the Office of Immigration Statistics (OIS) recommended that use of the PAS system be discontinued effective July 1, 2004. Based on these joint recommendations, mainframe access to the Investigations sub system in PAS will be terminated on July 1, 2004.

Also effective July 1, 2004, all ICE Investigations case statistics (workload and hours) will be documented and collected exclusively through the (b) (7)(E) and (b) (7)(E) systems. (b) (7)(E) reporting systems will be used as the principle reporting system for analysis of OI enforcement statistics. The use of G-23.19 through G-23.20 of the Report of Field Operations will be terminated with the full conversion of (b) (7)(E) on July 1, 2004.
