Introduction

The Facilities Legal Resource Guide provides an overview of legal services in each ICE detention facility. Listed by Area of Responsibility (AOR), the guide contains information specific to each detention facility including the law library hours of operation and available resources, the availability of Legal Orientation Program (LOP) and other legal rights group presentations and providers onsite or telephonically, as well as other legal materials available to detainees. The guide serves a reference tool for Detention Information Reporting Line (DRIL) call analysts, detained noncitizens and law library coordinators.

Under each facility, there is information about whether the congressionally appropriated and government sponsored Department of Justice's Executive Office of Immigration Review (EOIR) LOP is provided or if, in the alternative, there is a legal service provider that provides legal rights group orientations or direct pro bono representation. In all cases where there is not an EOIR LOP, the nationwide program by ABA speed dial number should be provided. The UNHCR line can also be provided in cases that involve an asylum-seeker or a detained individual who states they have asylum-related questions.

Additionally, all detained noncitizens should be referred to the LOP resources available on the electronic law library. If the detained noncitizen cannot find LOP resources in their preferred language, the detained noncitizen can submit a detainee request form or call back to the DRIL. Recorded audio LOP orientations are also available upon request.

The new section "Communicating with Legal Representatives Information" details in-person and virtual (if available) attorney visitation hours, as well as information on the availability of electronic exchange of documents. **Legal representatives should be directed to facility pages for further information and the new Attorney Information and Resources page on ICE.gov:**

SPECIAL ACCOMMODATIONS FOR DETAINEES WITH DISABILITIES, LIMITED-ENGLISH PROFICIENCY (LEP), OR WHO ARE ILLITERATE

Subject to ICE detention standards and other applicable laws, communication assistance is available to detainees who are limited English proficient or illiterate. Written material provided to detainees is translated into Spanish, and oral interpretation is available for law library or LOP instructions/notices that are not written in a detainee's language or where the detainee is illiterate.

For detainees with disabilities, per federal law, the facility is required to provide accommodations so that the law library is accessible to them. Accommodations for those that have a disability include but are not limited to: sign language interpretation, braille and text readers, and adaptations to physical spaces and/or assistive devices.

Detainees can request these accommodations by contacting any facility staff, medical staff, ICE personnel, or calling the DRIL.
