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

SUBJECT: Office of Investigations Protocol in Support of Department of
Defense Facilities

This memorandum provides guidance and institutes reporting requirements for all Office of Investigations (OI) personnel providing support to Department of Defense (DoD) facilities¹. Special Agent in Charge (SAC) offices are requested to respond to DoD facilities requesting assistance regarding immigration related employment issues to the maximum extent allowable. In conjunction with the National Security Investigations Division (NSID), the Critical Infrastructure Protection and Fraud Division has identified a need for close coordination between OI personnel and DoD facilities nationwide.

When a request for assistance is received by ICE from a DoD commander or law enforcement officer, the OI field office should initiate a preliminary inquiry to determine if an investigation is warranted. (b) (7)(E)

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¹ For the purposes of this memorandum, the term "facilities" includes but is not limited to: bases, posts, depots, armories, contract facilities labs, ports and camps.

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




IMAGE coordinators should incorporate DoD facilities into their current outreach program.
