

Operation Predator Notices for Interpol

Purpose

Recently, each Field Office Director received a list of Operation Predator cases identified for their respective area of responsibility as well as instructions for completing Interpol Green Notice applications on each case. This memorandum serves as follow-up to that message and establishes policy for future case preparation in regards to cases removed pursuant to Operation Predator.

Background

The location, apprehension and removal of Operation Predator violators continues to be a priority for Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE). It is ICE's intent to ensure that these predators do not prey upon others upon their return to their country of origin. (b)(7)(E)
