




- 1. **PURPOSE**: The purpose of this directive is to set forth the policy and procedures for the IHSC ICE Credentials Program.
- APPLICABILITY: This directive applies to U.S. Immigration and Customs
 Enforcement (ICE) Health Service Corps (IHSC) U.S. Public Health Service (PHS) officers and civil service employees.
- 3. AUTHORITIES AND REFERENCES:
 - **3-1.** ICE Policy 3002.1, section 4.3, ICE Badge and Credential Program, effective January 12, 2010.
- 4. POLICY: IHSC will issue ICE credentials to personnel who require the identification as evidence of their authority, when interacting with federal, state, local, or foreign officials. The Taskings and Program Support Unit (TPSU) oversees and implements the IHSC ICE Credentials Program in accordance with ICE policy.


