## **General Information**

The Student and Exchange Visitor Program (SEVP) will deploy SEVP Portal Release 6.1 on Friday, May 24, 2024.

This release will fix the following known issues:

- Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM) reporting and validation dates will appear in student Portal records.
- Students will receive one correct Portal Closure email.
- Portal accounts will become "Read Only"16 days after the student's optional practical training (OPT) and/or STEM extension ends.
- Portal Reset Account link on the Student and Exchange Visitor Information System (SEVIS) *Student Information* page will function correctly.
- SEVIS to Portal and Portal to SEVIS transmissions will send correct information and update both SEVIS and Portal event histories accurately.
- When a student's new period of post-completion OPT begins, the Portal will send an account creation email to the student.

- Students will not be able to log into the SEVP Portal during the outage.
